## 2021 UNIVANTS Awards: Thirteen Teams from Around the World Recognized for Healthcare Excellence



IFCC, in partnership with Abbott and 6 other global healthcare organizations are celebrating the success of 13 teams across the globe who have received global recognition for healthcare excellence. By "UNIFYING" across disciplines for the development and implementation of "AVANT-GARDE" processes, each of the recognized teams achieved measurably better healthcare, awarding them prestigious honors and association with the UNIVANTS of Healthcare Excellence awards.

The winning 2021 care initiatives involved innovative, diverse, and inspiring outcomes that spanned multiple disease states, clinical pathways, geographical locals and healthcare disciplines.
